# Information for applicants for doctoral study program FAFNR on the CULS

### 1. Basic Provisions

Doctoral study program (hereinafter DSP) is designed for graduates of universities who graduated by a state examination Master's degree program in the field covered by the DSP in connected or related field. The basic objective is to obtain a DSP and demonstrate the ability of independent scientific work in the field of science and processing of the defense of the doctoral dissertation, publications and other forms of presentation own scientific-research activities, including passing all the tests and the state doctoral examination. Graduates DSP will obtain academic title "Doctor" (abbreviated to "Ph.D." behind the name).

### 2. Forms of DSP

**Full-time** DSP is the only form of doctoral studies for foreign students. The duration of this form of study is four years. Students of full DSP have the status of university students (discount on fares, accommodation on campus, eating in the canteen for student rates etc.). After a period of study are granted scholarships piperdinium are entitled to six weeks of vacation per calendar year.

# 3. Admission Proceedings

Takes place before the commission appointed by the dean of the faculty at doctoral board and is composed of leading experts in the relevant scientific field. The exam is oral, whose professional part-becoming of the issues related to the field to which the applicant wishes to study. Further test consists of two foreign languages or only English language. Admission proceedings can be replaced by written recommendation from two Professors.

## 4. Fields of DSP study

It is recommended for applicants to contact supervisor (see: The Topics for Doctoral Study Programme in the Academic Year 2017/2018) (e.g. the head of department)

Have on mind that if accepted you will have to pay 500,- EUR per academic year and you will have to cover your living expenses (approx. 300,- EUR/month).

## 5. Deadline and application in the admission process

Admissions to the above disciplines DSP will be held on June 20, 2017.

Foreign applicants have to contact proper supervisor before submitting the application. For studies conducted in a foreign language is a set fee of 500 EUR for each calendar year. This fee is not required for students coming within intercollegiate or inter-faculty contracts.
